Grammar I is a review of the grammar concepts taught in 4th grade, Grammar II is a review of the grammar concepts taught in 5th and 6th grades, and Grammar III is a review of grammar concepts taught in 7th and 8th grades. The instruction is tailored to fit all types of learners and includes games and activities interspersed in the three-hour sessions. These sessions are designed to help students gain more confidence in grammar and the incorporation of grammatical structures into writing. Please note that current middle school students have priority in admission for Grammar II and III. For Grammar I, priority will go to new rising 5th graders who have scored poorly on the grammar test given in May to all new students.
