

**ASSISTANCE LEAGUE OF ATLANTA**— This project is a Peer-Leadership Group Project. Peer group 1 and their leaders will be assigned this project. 2

*projects:* 6 students will be sorting clothes for Thrift Store, another 7 students will be bagging new clothes &/or healthcare kits for Operation School Bell.
