A GREAT WAY TO MANAGE YOUR BREAKFAST ACCOUNT!

A computerized declining balance system is available to all Wesleyan students participating in the Breakfast @ Wesleyan program. The system enhances the management of your student's breakfast account at Wesleyan. The biggest benefits of the system are for you, the parent.

- *Electronic statements and reports
- *Payment by credit card
- *24 hour posting of funds to the account
- *Ability to view student's purchases

ACCOUNT INFORMATION AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

The declining balance system offers parents account information at their fingertips. From your own computer you may log into a secure website and manage your student's breakfast account.

The website address is:

www.mykidsspending.com

When you go on line and sign up for this service your log in and password for this website will be sent to you by e-mail.

Once you log into the website you can view your student's account information, and make deposits using Visa or MasterCard. Deposited funds take 24 hours to post to your student's account. There is a minimum charge of \$50 and a 4% fee or \$3 whichever is higher at the time of the deposit.*

ELECTRONIC STATEMENTS SENT TO YOU BY E-MAIL

Once a month, you will receive an electronic statement from SAGE Dining Services. The statement includes up-to-date account balance, history of deposits and a list of transactions made by your student. Low balance notices are also sent by e-mail when the account reaches \$12.00.

The e-mail address you provide to SAGE is only used for communication regarding your student's balance account. Please make sure Wesleyan has your correct e-mail address. This is crucial for the system to work.

There are a number of very powerful reasons to participate in the declining balance system at school:

Safety: Students do not carry cash, and funds on deposit are transferred from semester to semester and year to year.

Control: Parents/Guardians can rest assured that funds meant for the breakfast program will be spent on food at the breakfast program.

Speed: Debit transactions are much faster than cash, meaning your student has more time to enjoy their breakfast.
